

Computer Sale FAQ's

How old are the computers?

Most of the computers are about four years old and are a part of the Dell swap out, some are slightly newer.

Are they under warranty?

Yes, they are under warranty for approximately three months at the time of purchase, unless otherwise noted, and those under warranty can be extended directly through Dell.

Can I buy more than one?

You can purchase more than one desktops because we have a larger quantity. Laptops will be sold one per family, per transaction.

I am on vacation during the sale. Can I buy it ahead of time?

You may purchase desktops, but not laptops, due to the high demand.

What software/operating system comes with the computers?

Windows XP operating system and AVG anti-virus come on all computers. Desktops also have a memory upgrade of at least 1GB

How much do they cost?

Desktops will be \$150 and laptops are \$250.

You can pay with cash, credit or debit (Visa and MasterCard accepted), sorry, paper/personal checks will not be accepted. Additional discounts are available for larger purchases, please ask at the sale.
