

# Heritage Grove QR Tags

---

A **QR code (Quick Response code)** is a two-dimensional bar code designed to be read by smart phones. Using a QR app, center the code on your screen. The reader will automatically focus and scan the code. You can click to open the web page or share it with another smart phone user.

## Working with QR (Quick Response) Codes

(Check with cell phone provider to ensure your service plan supports Internet and data plan for use of QR Codes to not incur extra cell phone charges.)

1. Your Smartphone must have a camera and Internet data service plan to scan these QR Codes. (Check with cell phone provider to ensure your service plan supports Internet and data plan for use of QR Codes to not incur extra cell phone charges.)
2. Check to see if your phone has an application that is already installed to read QR Codes or do a Google search for your model phone with “QR reader”.

For example: QR Droid (Android); NeoReader (iPhone); and, QR Code Scanner Pro Free (Blackberry)

3. When you see a QR code, use your phone's application to scan it.
4. You can try scanning codes from your phone right now. (See codes on front of page) Place this on your fridge for quick reference to common places on our school's website. \*
5. Once you have opened the page, you can bookmark it for a quick “on the go” reference.

\*Some pages, like schedules, manuals and online textbook are pdf documents. Your phone will download these pages. On some phones, it may appear to have frozen the screen. Check your download screen to view them.
