Classroom Phase

- Rules of the Road Book (Chapters 1-13)
- Permit Exam (9 month permit)
- Responsible Driving Book (Chapters 1-19)
- Dailey Homework
- 6 Unit Tests
- Map Work Project
- Guest Speakers (Trains, A.B.A.T.E., Insurance, Police Officer)

- Attendance (30 + hours)

Driver Education

Behind the Wheel Phase (\$125 BTW Lab Fee)

- 56 Hours required to get license (40 daytime, 10 Nighttime)
- 6 Hours of Driving with an Instructor
- 12 Lessons
- 50 Hours log sheet
- Students are pulled out of classroom to drive
- Must have permit with them to be able to drive
- Remaining lessons taught before and after school
- Students are scheduled by Age (Oldest students go first)
- Absences (2 unexcused absences equals a drop to bottom of list)
- Failure (no fees to repeat, 1 quarter waiting period)
- Cars will run from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm
