

2008 PLAINFIELD HOMECOMING PARADE RULES & FACTS

Entry Size:

Average sized entries should be no larger than a float/hayrack and the vehicle pulling the float, along with walking participants.

“Walking Entry” (no float or vehicle) will be allowed the same amount of space as a float entry.

Entries may not exceed 13 feet, 6 inches in height, which is the legal limit, in order to clear trees and power lines.

Oversized entries: may be placed at the end of the parade.

Political entries: will be placed at the end of the parade.

School and Reunion entries must be in place by no later than 8:00 A.M. Judging begins promptly at 8:00 A.M.

If quantity of entries should exceed the time constraints of the parade, priority will go to school entries and bands and then a decision will be made at the discretion of the parade committee.

No projectiles will be launched from any entry at any time.

The parade begins at Lockport Street and VanDyke Road. **No standing or parade viewing will be allowed on the DuPage River Bridge.** The parade can be viewed along Lockport Street west of the bridge and also at the Village Green.

The parade line-up will be at the Ira Jones Middle School campus, 15320 Wallin Drive, just south of the Avery YMCA. Participants should approach the line-up from Lockport Street near the YMCA.

THE PARADE ENDS AT THE PHS SOUTH PARKING LOT on Fort Beggs Drive just east of James Street. **All bands and entries that need to unload anyone or anything must proceed into the parking lot.**

DO NOT UNLOAD ON FORT BEGGS DRIVE OR JAMES STREET

Individual vehicles that do not require unloading may proceed south on River Road (James Street) or east on Fort Beggs Drive at the end of the parade.
