The results are in. For those who attended the Know Your District 202 Schools informational addresses in October, the events expanded their knowledge regarding important topics facing our school district.

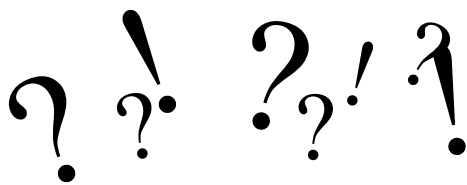
More than 90% of the attendees said the presentations increased their knowledge about the District's Growth, Five-Year Planning, Financial Resources, and Human Resources. More than 80% responded that the presentations increased their knowledge

about the District's Continuous Student Achievement and the 2004-2005 Program of Work.

As Board President Ron Kazmar and Superintendent John Harper remarked during the presentations, the informational addresses were aimed at beginning a dialogue within the school community about the successes and challenges facing District 202. It is important to take time to celebrate the great things that are happening everyday for our students. It is just as important to recognize the challenges

we face so that we as a community can address them. It is the Board of Education and Administration's intent that these informational addresses will spur conversations that will help move us closer to achieving our vision of preparing learners for the future.

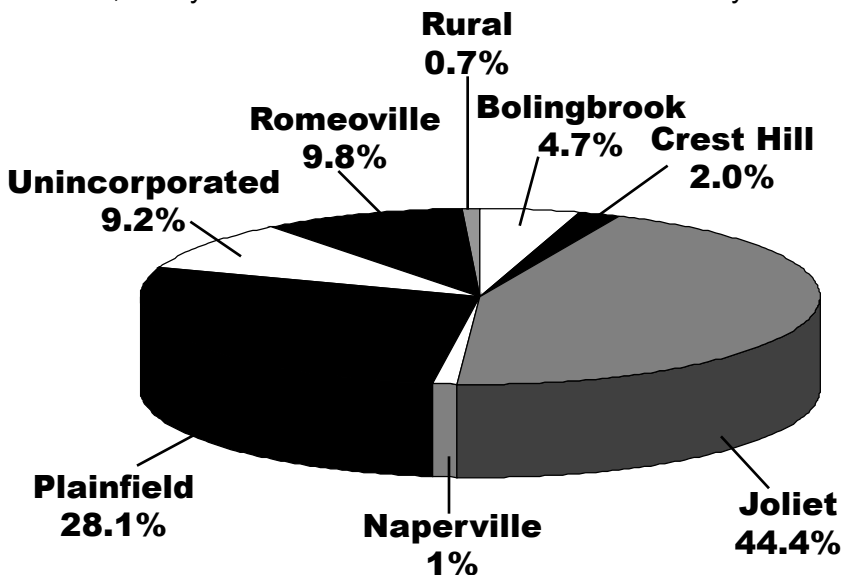

### Where Our Students Live

District 202 serves a 64-square-mile area that includes parts of six municipalities and two counties. While residents may pay taxes for different municipal services, park districts, or library districts, all residents served by District 202 pay the same tax rate to support the school district. This pie chart depicts where our 21,674 students reside. At the Know Your District 202 Schools address, Superintendent Dr. John Harper asked residents to remember that each student is important to us when he said, "They are all our students no matter where they live."



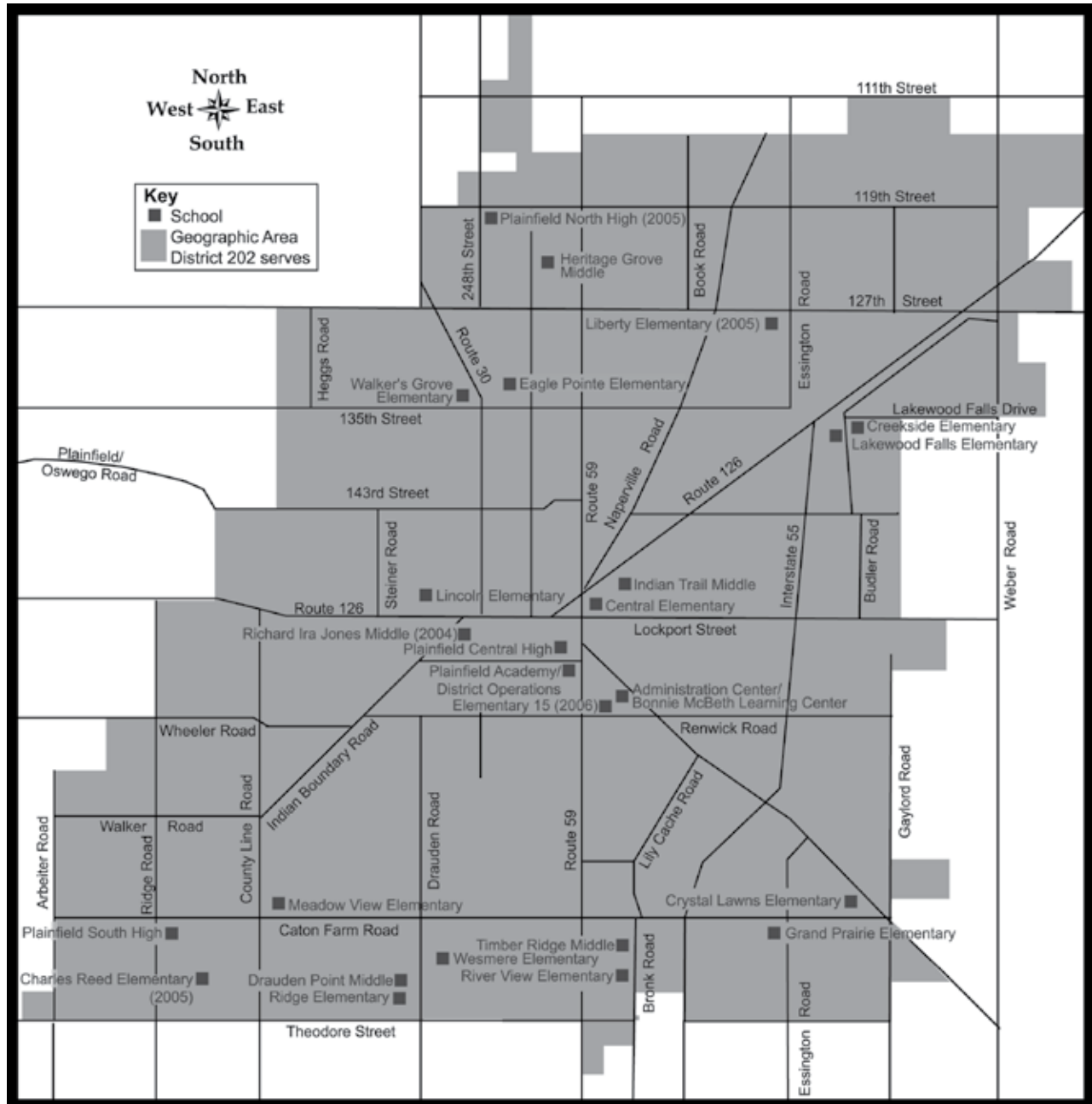

# Attendance zone recommendation timeline outlined

In 2005-2006, District 202 will open three new schools — Liberty Elementary, Charles Reed Elementary, and Plainfield North High. The administration will present an attendance zone recommendation to the Board of Education by winter break. To allow for public input, the process will take place over a series of three Board meetings.

- Meeting One: Recommendation presented
- Communication of recommendation to the community
- Meeting Two: Public input
- Board consideration of input and direction to administration
- Meeting Three: Board action
- Communication of decision to the community

The specific dates of these meetings will be established and communicated later this fall.
