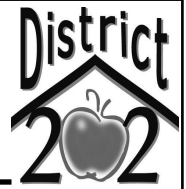

### Kindergarten

- 8 wide dry erase markers - black
- 6 large glue sticks
- 2 dozen #2 pencils (sharpened)
- 2 boxes 24 regular crayons
- 2 sturdy pocket folders (no fasteners), 1 red and 1 blue
- 1 box facial tissue
- 1 pair gym shoes for physical education days
- 1 supply box
- 1 box 8 classic washable markers
- 1 spiral notebook (70-100 pages)
- 1 highlighter
- 1 pair 5-inch blunt tip scissors
- 1 pair headphones or earbuds
- 1 art shirt
- 1 box quart or sandwich size Ziploc bags (girls)
- 1 box gallon size Ziploc bags (boys)

### Full Day Kindergarten

- 8 wide dry erase markers - black

### First Grade

- 2 packs 3x3-inch sticky notes
- 1 pair 5-inch blunt tip scissors
- 1 12 inch ruler (1/4 inch scale)
- 1 eraser for white board
- 1 pair headphones or earbuds
- 1 pair gym shoes for physical education days
- 1 art shirt
- 1 box gallon-size Ziploc bags (boys)
