DISTRICT 202 COVID-19/CORONAVIRUS UPDATE

TOPICS ADDED THIS WEEK

RE: Remote Learning

- “School” is [closed on Friday, April 10 and Monday, April 13, 2020](#). Therefore, students DO NOT need to do Remote Learning on those days.

[Remote Learning](#) resumes April 14, 2020. Students should be prepared to participate, with or without a computer. Remember, you do NOT need a computer for Remote Learning.

RE: Updated Lunch Service:

- The [schedule for lunch service](#) for all students 18 years old and younger will change again next week.
- Starting the week of April 13, 2020 and until further notice, meal service will be provided one day per week on Wednesdays from 9-11 a.m.
 - Families will receive 5 breakfasts and 5 lunches (one time-fresh /frozen meals) with cooking instructions per child 18 years and younger.
- Families who are not able to pick up a meal should call (815) 577- 4046.

RE: Kindergarten-Related Topics

- **Kindergarten registration** will be held at the home schools as usual, as soon as possible when school resumes.
- All children chosen for **2020-21 Full-Day Kindergarten** will still be able to complete enrollment and registration when school resumes.

As in previous years, parents may decide to not complete enrollment/registration for any reason, however no child will lose his/her Full-Day Kindergarten “spot” because of the COVID-19 closure.

- **Kindergarten Round-up Events** are postponed and will be rescheduled when school resumes.

RE: Retrieving Student Belongings from School

- Parents and students are not allowed to enter District 202 facilities at this time. Parents will be allowed to retrieve student belongings as soon as possible when school resumes.

PREVIOUS TOPICS

RE: “Rite of Passage Events” like Prom, Graduation, 8th grade promotion:

- At this time, these events have been postponed, but not cancelled. District 202 will decide whether to cancel or move these events (and related logistic details) when the state decides if/when school will resume.

RE: Waiving/refunding School-related Fees

- More information will follow soon regarding refunds or crediting of student accounts for school related events (field trips), programs (full-day kindergarten, preschool, etc.) and athletics.
- District 202 recently suspended tuition payments for the time-being for full-day kindergarten and tuition-based preschool.

RE: The status of spring athletics and extracurricular events

- SOME (but not all) athletic events have been canceled, however to the best of our knowledge we are not aware that entire sports seasons have been canceled. Please refer to the Illinois High School Association website for the most current guidance: www.ihsa.org
