IDPH Return to School Requirements

According to the Illinois Department of Public Health and the Will County Health Department, your child must quarantine/isolate until you meet the all the criteria to return in either A, B, C, or D as listed below.

Medical evaluation and testing are strongly recommended for all persons with COVID-like symptoms.

A. COVID Like Symptoms	B. Physician Confirmed Condition
<p>The student can return when ALL 3 of the below criteria have been met:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Home for 10 days since the onset of symptoms, AND 2. At least 24 hours with no fever <i>without the use of fever reducing medication</i> AND 3. Symptoms have improved/resolved AND 4. A note from Parent/Guardian documenting the ill student or household contacts are without a fever without the use of fever reducing medication and symptoms have improved. 	<p>If your physician has confirmed your child has a non-COVID viral illness, student may return with:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A doctor's note explaining an individualized plan of care for your child's specific medical concern. AND 2. 24 hours fever free <i>without the use of fever reducing medication</i> AND/OR 3. 24 hours of antibiotic treatment for contagious infections when appropriate

C. If your child receives a Negative COVID 19 Diagnostic Test WITHIN 48 hours of symptom onset:	
<i>With clinical evaluation</i>	<i>Without clinical evaluation</i>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Provide a dated Negative Nasal Swab (RT-PCR COVID-19) test result OR 2. Health care provider's note indicating the negative RT-PCR test results AND 3. Health care provider note with: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Alternative diagnosis AND • Return to school date consistent with school policies for the diagnosis. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Provide a dated Negative Nasal Swab (RT-PCR COVID-19) test result AND 2. Stay home until symptoms have resolved.

D. <u>If your child is diagnosed with COVID-19</u>	
<u>Please contact your child's school and they will refer you to the building contact tracer</u>	
Diagnosis, No Symptoms	Diagnosis, Symptoms
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Home for 10 days since first positive COVID test AND 2. Must provide date proof of COVID test AND 3. Release from Isolation letter from the Will County Health Department 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Home for 10 days since symptom appeared AND 2. At least 24 hours fever-free <i>without fever reducing medication</i> AND 3. Symptoms have improved AND 4. Release from Isolation letter provided by the Will County Health Department.
