The reports that you are receiving reflect your child's individual performance on the Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers (PARCC) exam, in English Language Arts (ELA) and math.

The PARCC exam asks students to demonstrate and apply their knowledge and skills, rather than simply answering recall and forced choice questions. The test aligns with the Illinois Learning Standards and measures students' problem-solving abilities, critical thinking, and writing skills.

No test provides a complete picture of student performance, and the PARCC exam results are simply one of many factors that we use to measure progress. Each school in Plainfield Consolidated Community District 202 utilizes several types of assessments to develop, refine, and improve their instructional programs in order to continually challenge students and increase student achievement.
