The below is a self-screening Plainfield School District Employees reporting to a facility. All District 202 employees must complete the self-screening every morning prior to reporting to work.

People with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported – ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear **2-14 days after exposure to the virus.**

<p>Outside of the work environment in the last 14-days, have you had close contact with or cared for someone diagnosed with COVID-19 or that had all the symptoms of COVID-19?</p> <p><i>Symptoms listed above. *Close contact is defined as being within approximately 6 feet of a COVID-19 case for greater than 6 minutes; close contact can occur while caring for, living with, visiting, or sharing a healthcare waiting area or room with a COVID-19 case or having direct contact with infectious secretions of a COVID-19 case (e.g., being coughed on)</i></p>
