Dear District 202 Wilco Families,

Wilco will begin instruction for District 202 students on August 31st. Students should receive an invitation to join their Wilco Google classroom via the student's Plainfield email, but students will have a separate Wilco email for the classroom.

Directions for Google classroom can be found on the Wilco website. **If your child does not receive the information, please contact Wilco at 815-838-6941.** Wilco instructors will provide live (synchronous) and on demand (asynchronous) sessions for students via Google classroom along with assignments and resources for the program.

Wilco will also be scheduling students into labs at the Center; however, not all programs will have lab time associated with the class during this first nine weeks.

Students in **Welding, Auto, Construction, Culinary, EMS, Certified Nursing Assistant, Medical Assistant and Veterinary Assisting** will have an opportunity to come into the Center for lab experiences.

***Wilco is committed to maintaining a six-foot social distance for safety protocols for all students, so it is important for students to schedule their time with their instructor.

Students in **Certified Nursing Assistant, Culinary Arts II, EMS, Early Childhood II, Business Logistics, and Vet Assisting** will have an opportunity to check out their textbooks on Monday, August 24th or Tuesday, August 25th from 8 a.m. until 6 pm.

If your student is participating in an **off-campus course, Aviation Mechanics, AIM, ACE, Barbering, Cisco, Cosmetology, Heavy Equipment or Nail Tech**, they should receive information from the college or site. If you have not received any information, please contact Wilco.

Driving passes will be issued to students who will be driving to Wilco. Wilco does not charge a parking fee. However, attendance must be coordinated with the Wilco Instructor.
