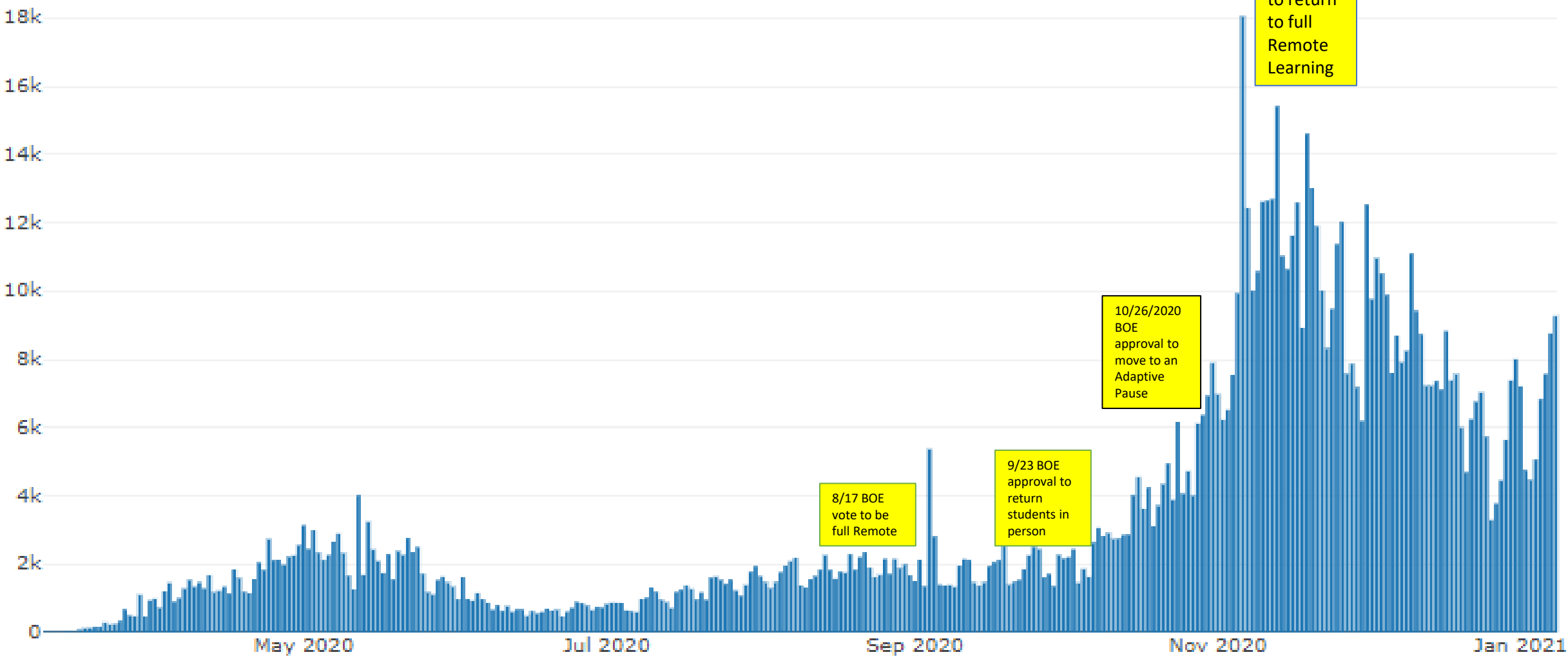

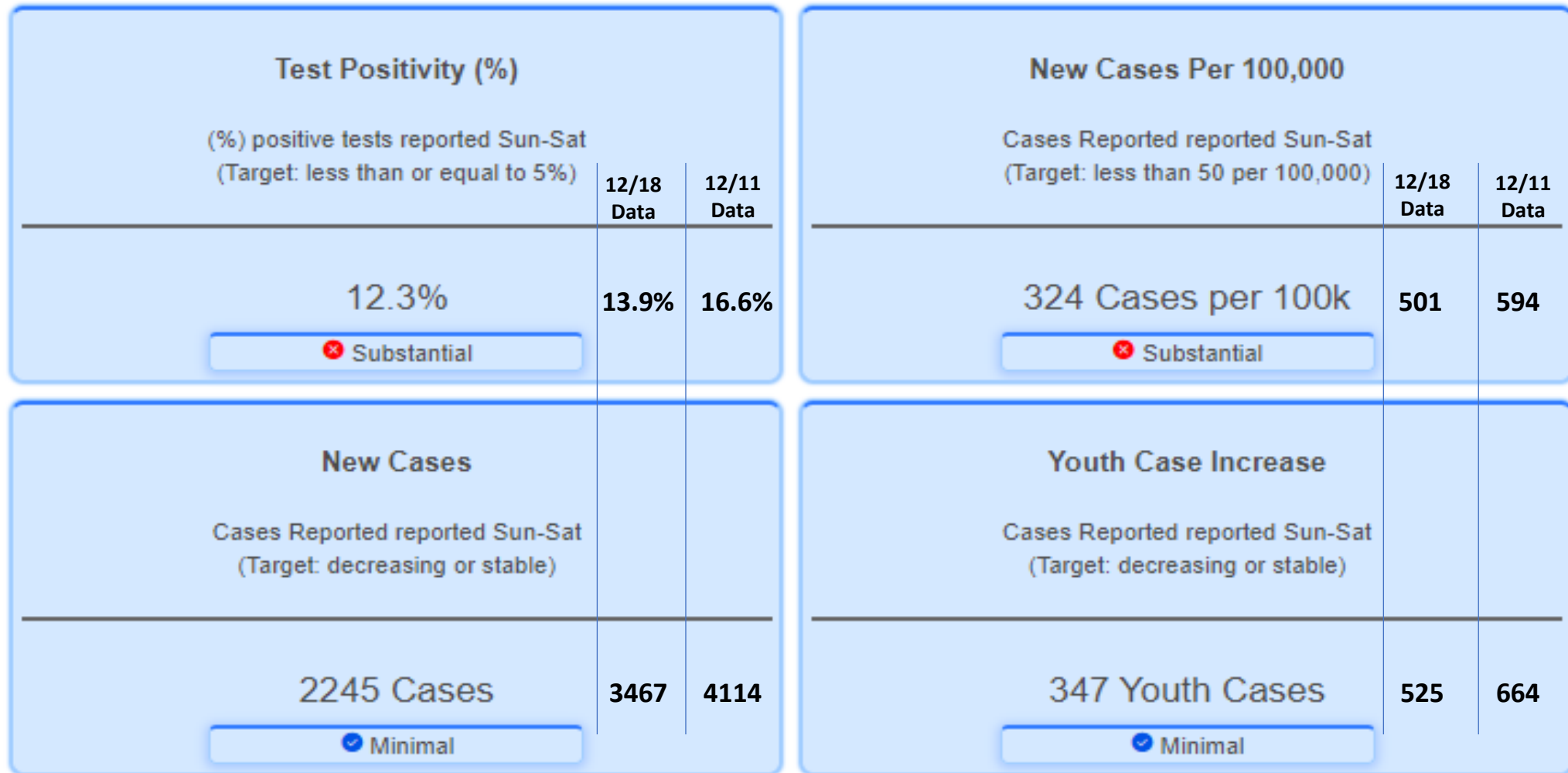

Week 53: 12/27/2020 Through 1/2/2021



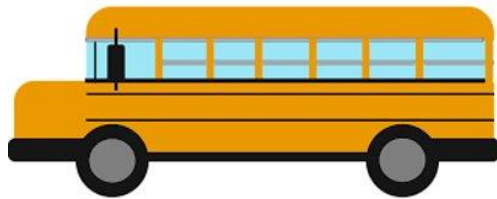

Tentative timeline:

- Jan 15 - Parents and students will be informed of their child's days for in-person learning.
- Jan 19 - New schedule starts for all levels.
- Jan 25 - PreK-12 multi-needs and specialized programs begin hybrid in-person instruction.
- Feb 1 - 6th grade, 9th grade, 1-12 Instructional Special education
- Feb 1 - *SIP day – no instruction for Pre-K and K
- Feb 2 - PreK instructional Special Education (Early Childhood), All Kindergarten
- Feb 8 - PreK tuition, Pre-School for All, Grades 1, 2, 7, 12
- Feb 16 - Grades 3,4,5, 8, 10, 11

- All remote days are synchronous
- Students in Specialized programs will follow the same schedule as first semester

Current Status - Adaptive Pause

- Currently - All 11 regions of Illinois COVID Regions are in **Tier 3 Mitigations**
- When there is **Community Transmission** at a substantial rate/level: IDPH recommends that districts should consider adaptive pause strategies such as:
 - Extend remote learning
 - Cancel/Postpone after school events such as sports or extra-curriculars
 - Continue meal programs
- Tier 1 students started on 10/26/2020, due to the rapid increase of Covid 19 metrics, adaptive pause for all grades began 11/16/2020.
- Families were asked to complete an **Educational Choice Form** after Thanksgiving Break to share intentions for 3rd quarter if it is safe to return to school. Families were given the opportunity to choose between Hybrid or Remote Learning for each child.
- Using information and data from the educational choice form completed by parents in conjunction with scheduling logistics and teacher and staff input the return plan has been updated to reflect tonight's presentation.
