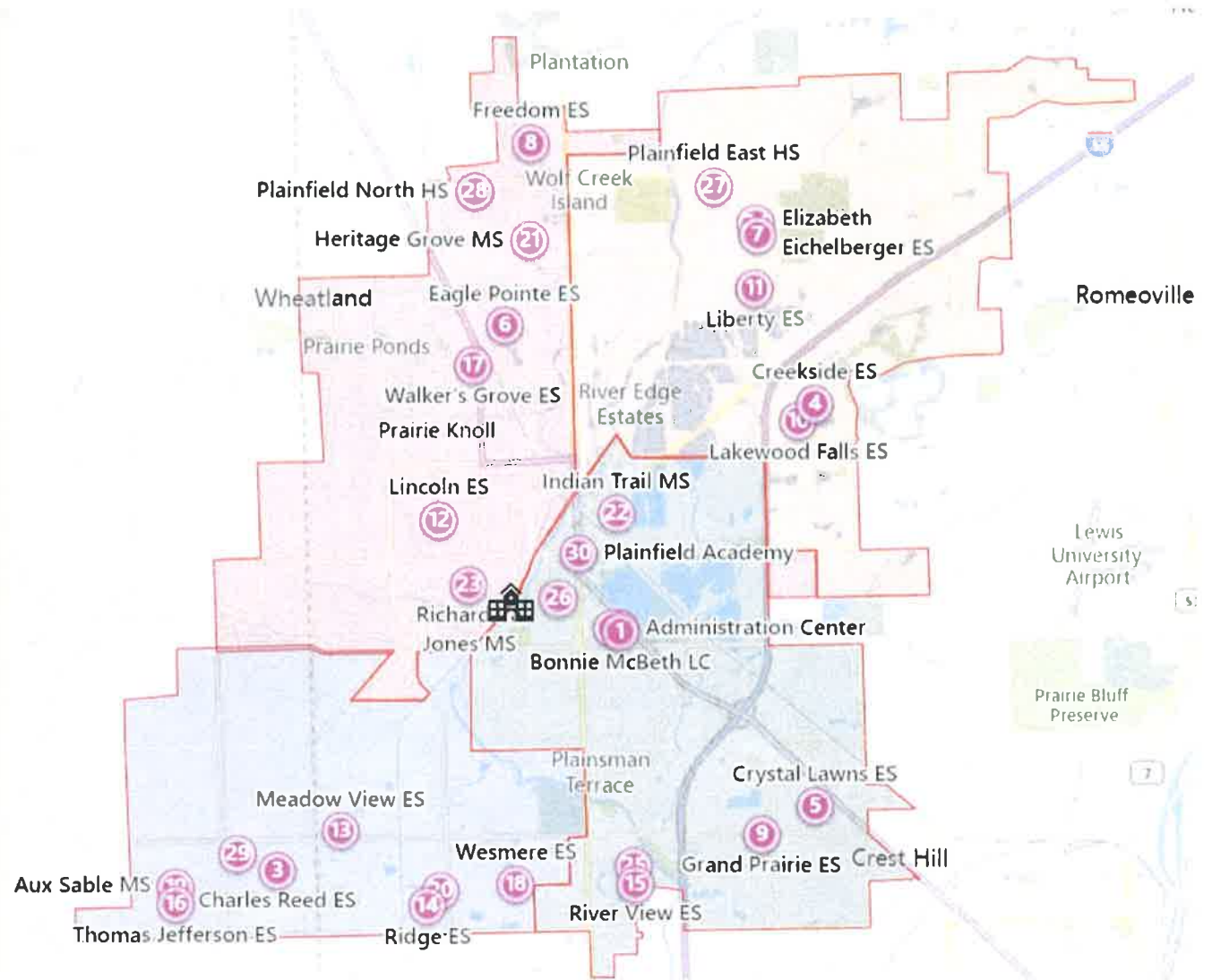

Why was a new elementary school built?

*To accommodate full day kindergarten for all eligible students in neighborhood schools (Recommendation of previous Strategic Plan)



*Providing stabilization of locations for our specialized elementary special education programs (BASES, STAR Plus, FBI, some pre-school programs, etc)



Guiding Principles in Decision Making:

- *Disrupt as few students as possible

- *If students need to move, keep them in their same feeder house



- *Balancing of enrollments at schools



- *Maximize efficiency of transportation



- *Do not add significant travel times or distances



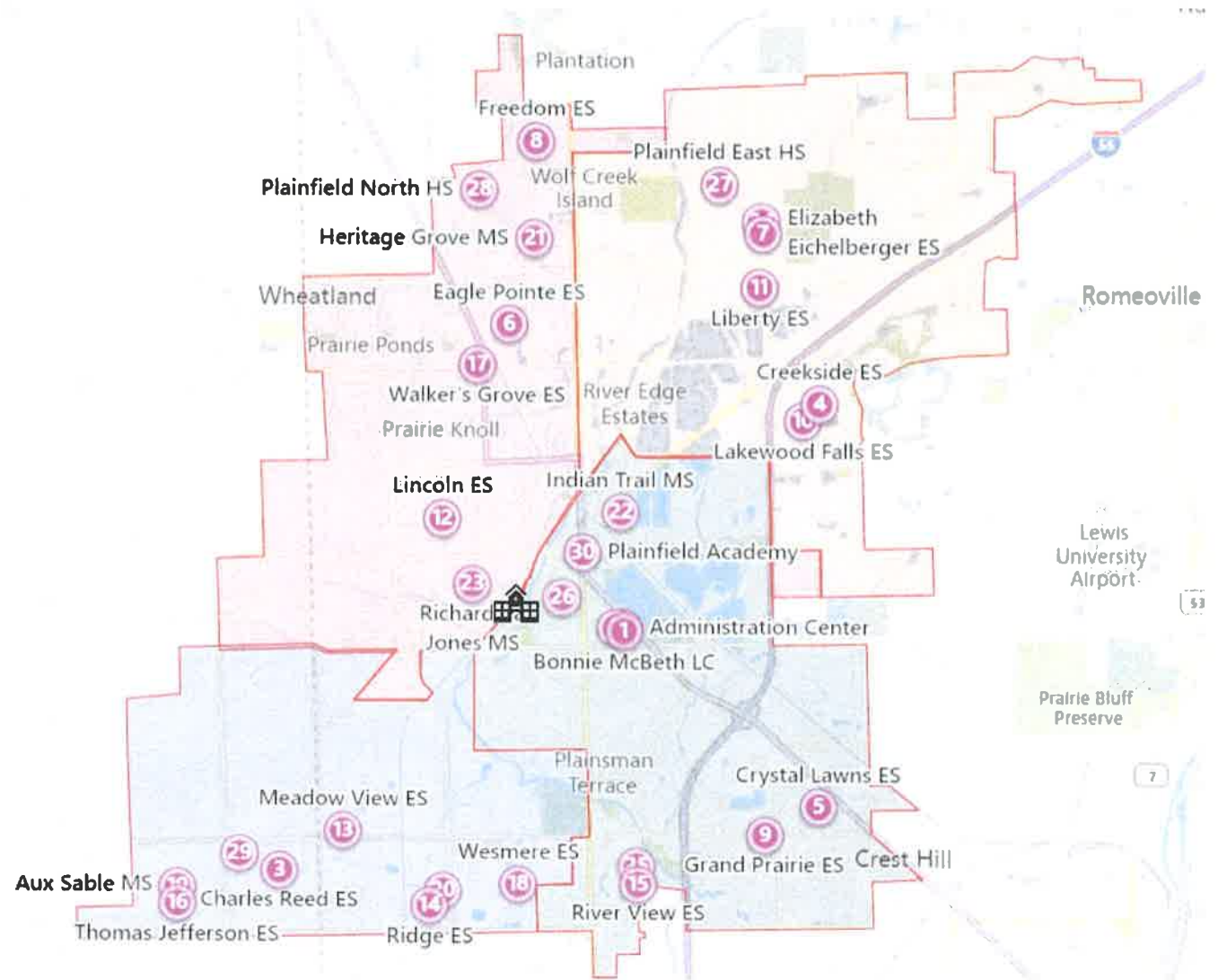
- *Adjust some outlier areas

- *Allows for residential development and possible enrollment growth.



Number of students changing schools:

- *Elementary - 997 , 4%
- *Middle School – 226, <1%
- *High School - 108, <1%
