

REMOTE INSTRUCTION INFORMATION

Your child has to quarantine. Here is information related to remote instruction, during the quarantine period of time.

Remote instruction will be made available for students only while they are under quarantine consistent with guidance or requirements from a local public health department. The District will follow the remote instruction requirements set forth by the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) as they relate to remote instruction.

District 202 remote instruction plan:

- Remote Instruction is offered through the teacher's Google Classroom for students who are sick from school and those who are required to quarantine.

- Daily assignments are posted by teachers in Google Classroom.

- Instruction is asynchronous. Asynchronous instruction allows students to view and complete the work on their own schedule. There will be no live instruction on Google Meets or Zoom, from the classroom teacher.

- Students that receive specialized instruction such as special education services, interventions, etc. will have assignments posted to the student's Google Classroom. These services will not be provided live or synchronous.

- Call the main office to set up a time to pick up/drop off your child's materials.

- Students may e-mail their classroom teacher for support on coursework. Please note, emails may not be returned during the teacher's work hours.

- Teachers will post work daily for students who are quarantined or sent home with symptoms.
