All affected students will be provided an E-Learning school day. They will log onto their Google Classrooms at the respected school start times and follow their daily schedule. Students and teachers will be synchronous for the school day with Google Meets being the platform for synchronous instruction.

All students are expected to login and attend their classes remotely just as a regular day. Regular absence procedures are to be followed if a student cannot attend remotely.

If students that are unable to participate in an E-Learning day then parents will need to call their student into the main office for attendance purposes and the students will be marked as an excused absence.

Teachers will post assignments, videos, links, into their Google Classroom and students will have the opportunity to complete the work without penalty upon returning to school.

STUDENT E-LEARNING SCHEDULES

Pre-School Students:

Log-on into their Google Classroom at the normal school start time and the teacher will have their Google Meets link posted on the Class Stream. Students will log onto the Google Meets and be provided live synchronous learning for their school day. Attendance will be taken by the teachers at the start of the day. Students and teachers will follow their daily schedule that was planned for in-person instruction on September 13, 2021. The day will be a combination of synchronous learning on Google Meets and independent work posted in Google Classroom. Teachers will provide E-Learning breaks to their students throughout the school day.

Elementary School Students:

Log-on at 9:05 am to their Google Classroom and the teacher will have their Google Meet link posted on the Class Stream. Students will log onto the Google Meet and be provided synchronous learning for their school day. Attendance will be taken by the teachers at the start of the day. Students and teachers will follow their daily schedule that was planned for in-person instruction on September 13, 2021. Teachers will provide E-Learning breaks to their students throughout the school day.

Middle School Students:

Log-on at 7:55 am to their Google Classroom and the teacher will have their Google Meet link posted on the Class Stream. Students will log onto the Google Meet and be provided synchronous learning for their school day. Students will be expected to log into each Google Classroom at the start of each period of the day for the teacher to record attendance. Students and teachers will follow their daily schedule that was planned for in-person instruction on September 13, 2021

High School Students:

Log-on at 7:05 am to their Google Classroom and the teacher will have their Google Meet link posted on the Class Stream. Students will log onto the Google Meet and be provided synchronous learning for their school day. Students will be expected to log into each Google Classroom at the start of each period of the day for the teacher to record attendance. Students and teachers will follow their daily schedule that was planned for in-person instruction on September 13, 2021.

All students K-12 will receive their scheduled special education services.
