ALICE TRAINING

Thank you to all of our buildings for hosting staff ALICE training sessions from members of our committee. We have now trained all of our 31 campuses to date. Student were trained at all 7 middle schools and 4 High Schools. Elementary buildings are working with their staff to provide age appropriate training at the classroom level.
