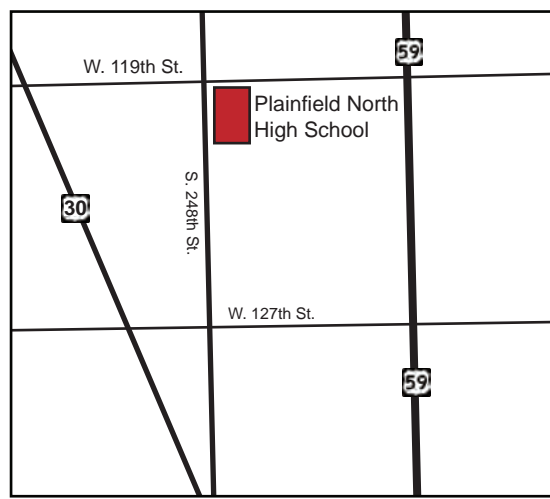

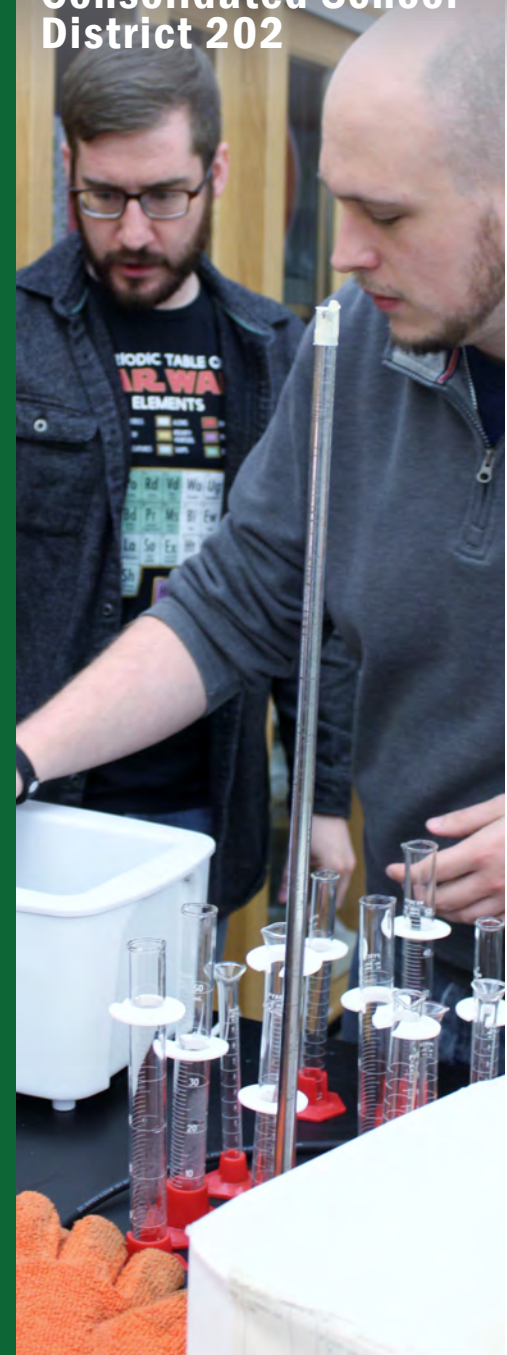

### Fee

A fee of \$500 includes the workshop instruction fees, daily lunches, and the workshop materials. This fee is payable to **Plainfield CCSD 202**.

If registration is canceled for any reason, the individual or organization making the payment will receive: (1) full refund, less an administrative fee of \$25, if the cancellation is received by June 1st, or (2) no refund for a "No Show" or a cancellation received after June 1st.
