 - Staffing: 1 painting supervisor, 12 painting crew workers, 4 maintenance helpers, 20 custodial helpers, 1 grounds supervisor and 8 ground helpers. Estimated cost \$270,237.00
- Approval of Technology Summer Workers. Tentative time frame of 13 weeks from 05/29/2023 to 08/21/2023 (consisting of a 4 day work week @ 10 hours a day). Hourly rate: \$14 for workers.
 - Staffing: 10 summer workers. Projects to be completed include computer deployment; clean up and redistribution of loaned laptops from lockdown and additional network projects. Estimated Costs: \$69,160.00
